Where is the company located?

Located in Somerset, WI, we are a company owned by women. Our entire product line is available for shipping within the United States. Not only are we more cost-effective than our competitors, but we also offer distinct features that set us apart. While there are comparable products that serve as the foundation for our robot system, none match the diversity of accessories we provide. With patents in hand, we stand as the exclusive source for the MotoShot line of products.

Who provides the training for the product?

We do not offer training services. Instead, we supply all our equipment, designed for effortless use straight out of the box with minimal instructions. Recognizing the unique training protocols of each state and agency, we believe that individuals responsible for leading firearms training using our product are most qualified to do so. This approach ensures that the designated trainer is the most suitable candidate for the job, aligning with state and agency requirements.

What are the expected maintenance costs?

The essential MotoShot items that require maintenance are the battery and the target, both considered consumables. Preserving the battery's health is paramount. Proper storage and regular charging are crucial for optimal performance. It is advisable to store batteries in a climate-controlled environment instead of leaving them outdoors. With a business history dating back to 2006, we take pride in the longevity of our robotic systems, with some original systems still in use since the inception of our operations.

Does the product need future upgrades, updates?

We design our products to be user-friendly. Our units don't incorporate any computer programs, eliminating the need for hardware or software updates. The individual with the remote has complete control over every aspect of the robot's movements, including speed, course, altitude, variable distance, and all directions.

Do you offer demos for your products?

We provide a DEMO program, allowing your department to personally demonstrate the exceptional value our product offers to the quality of training. Each DEMO is shipped via FedEx in our durable hard-side cases, requiring no setup. The package includes one Elite Standard Robot, a paper target bracket, a 2X4 target bracket (for the 3D Target), batteries/charger, and an MM3D Target. MotoShot DEMO allocations operate on a "first come, first serve" basis, and the demonstration period extends for 30 days.

During your 30-day DEMO period, we ask that your department schedules trainers and decision-makers to view the MotoShot, or ideally, attend a range event. This way they can gain a first-hand knowledge of MotoShot's applicability to training, from basic marksmanship to tactical courses. We believe offering a DEMO unit provides the opportunity for your department to see how MotoShot would be an essential tool for your training curriculum.

Do you offer price breaks for quantities purchased?

Throughout the years, we've identified the primary challenge confronting agencies in their pursuit of training equipment—financial constraints. In 2016, Hale Outdoor Products actively pursued and successfully secured a GSA Schedule Contract. This contract empowers government buyers with pre-approved pricing, meticulously assessed under the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation (DFAR).
